<u>Aims & Objectives</u>

To provide training in basic principles of knee arthroscopy and the range of common operative procedures performed in knee arthroscopy practice.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completing the course, participants will have developed the following surgical skills in a simulated setting: -

- Draping and portal placement for knee arthroscopy
- Conducting diagnostic knee arthroscopy
- Removing a loose body
- Performing a synovial biopsy
- Recognising the indications for and executing both medial and lateral arthroscopic meniscectomies
- Recognising the indications for and performing arthroscopic chondroplasty and debridement
- Recognising the indications for and executing microfractures
